Applicant must comply with the requirements of the approving Philippine Foreign Service Post (FSP). The Philippine Embassy in Lisbon will only review and verify your documents and if found compliant, we will forward the said application to appropriate FSP for their approval. Please be advised that the turnaround time for this process would take approximately 6-8 months depending on the volume of the documents being processed by the said FSP. Please note that these documents are sent via Lisbon -Manila-FSP then, once approved, the documents go through FSP-Manila-Lisbon as we do not have the facility to send civil registry documents directly to other FSP. Another option is to file it directly with the approving FSP for a faster turn-around time.
